- 1. Apologies for absence: Victoria Liston (VL). KP extended a welcome to AG who is a Coach in Training and volunteers on Saturday mornings. She has two more training modules to complete. KP will organise an ECC email address. Action: KP

- 3. Update and Matters arising since last meeting:
 - 1. Dressage Competition, ECC Sunday 12th December 2021. KP thanked all (including volunteers) for their help at the event which had good support from participants. Feedback from participants and parents has been overwhelmingly positive. SA, who judged, felt it was challenging, boosted the confidence of participants and they learnt a lot. She suggested that there could be a 'live' scoreboard with explanations for all and that in future, a quicker method of getting ponies in and ready for their riders would be helpful. It would also be helpful to explain to leaders how to lead on straight lines and on 20/10m circles. Parents/carers would benefit from understanding the concept of 'What is a Dressage Test?'. The ponies were well behaved and worked well for their riders. GD thought participants/families enjoyed the day and it was good to see the competition back again. KP thought the digital application forms worked well and it is good to have feedback from others. CD also agreed that there should be a scoreboard, someone to welcome parents/participants and explain the activities or have information on a noticeboard, introduce the judge, participants and suggested that the Chair or County Chairman should formally thank everyone at the end.
