Management Committee Meeting

Thursday, 17th February 2022, at 6.30pm, by Teams

- **1. Apologies for absence:** None.
- 2. Minutes of the Last Meeting: Approved.
- 3. Financial Update, Grant Applications, Championship.

KP reported that the CCLA Account has been closed and funds transferred to Barclays. There is £9K in the Restricted Fund, including £4K for a pony, £4.5K for Field Management and £180 in Bursary Fund. One Barclays account has been closed; KP suggested that we should open a new account for Designated Funds as this would be omitted when making Grant Applications. Based on our present funds, our cover is 9.27 months. Cover is presently set at 12 months.

AB reported that £2.5K grant has been received from St. James Place, for improved lighting in stables.

DP stated that to raise £20K, we need a Big Ticket Event, e.g. Charity Ball or Auction of Promises. The following Trustees will contact organisations for help with a function.

Bedford Park Rotary – VB. Kempston Rotary - RW. Bedford Lions – PF. Freemasons - KP. Round Table - KP. Blues Foundation - AB. Charles Wells Eagle Fund - VB. A separate meeting will be arranged to discuss.

After discussion, it was decided that the cost of private lessons should be raised from £20 to £25 for 30 minutes.

4. Covid Review

Masks – Required indoors (Gallery, Office, Tack Room). Side helpers in School Not Required outdoors (Yard, Site). Leading horses.

Unlimited number of volunteers allowed in Office.

Still require sign in (RDA policy) for Track and Trace.

Isolation period cut from 10 to 7 days.

Tack to be cleaned after each ride, but cleaning not required before the first ride each day.

MC agreed that we should be cautious but less strict. To be reviewed 31st March 2022.

Post meeting – agreed to the following additional changes in light of changes to guidance from NHS Track and Trace:

- Stop the requirement to have people check in when going to the centre
- Still require people not to come to the centre if they or someone in the household shows COVID or is positive for COVID for 7 days until at least the 1st April when free testing will stop.
- Open refreshments back to pre-covid however still focus on the individually wrapped food items. Encourage people to congregate / drink chat in the gallery.

5. Coaching Committee / Horses

Decision made to keep Rio on loan. His owner has kindly been providing feed during trial period and can take him back with 1 month's notice period. Rio's vet report has been accepted by the Council. £40 cost for Rio to be added to Bedford Borough Licence.

Huggy due to go to Horses' Trust on 31st March. LO (a Tuesday evening volunteer) to provide transport, VL will contribute to diesel cost.

Invoicing for participant fees has now been set up, our thanks to CP for supporting with this task.

Regionals 08/05/2022 / Nationals 15-17/07/2022

Both will be face-2-face this year. ECC riders will take part, but it is stressed that ECC is not able to contribute financially to either event. It is hoped Spillers may provide sponsorship. VL offered help with paperwork.
